

²¹ And the LORD God made for Adam and for his wife garments of skins and clothed them.










Exodus 12:7

The arrangement of the furniture in the Tabernacle
























The Tabernacle — the outside is what the world sees of Christ















The beauty of the inside of the Tabernacle is what we see of Christ




The Holy Places

- every item points to Christ






The Journey of Salvation

courtyard and entrance






The Church Revealed in the Tabernacle







