 Paul was not bashful when talking about money and giving.











 In Matt, Mark, and Luke, it is estimated that one out of every six verse, in some way deals with money.

 Of the 29 parables that Jesus told, 16 of them dealt with the person and their money









- The Bible has approximately 500 verses on the topic of prayer, fewer than 500 verses on the topic of faith, yet more than 2000 verses on money.
- Jesus taught and used more illustrations on the topic of money and possessions than all the teachings on heaven and hell combined.
 So, the Bible actually has a lot to say about money.









Luke 12:34

Jesus said: "where your treasure is there will your heart be also."

• 21 ²¹ "Yes, a person is a fool to store up earthly wealth but not have a rich relationship with God."

Luke 16:13 "..you cannot serve God and money..."









Phil 4:15-17 NLT

- 15 As you know, you Philippians were the only ones who gave me financial help when I first brought you the Good News and then travelled on from Macedonia. No other church did this. 16 Even when I was in Thessalonica you sent help more than once. 17 I don't say this because I want a gift from you. Rather, I want you to receive a reward for your kindness.
- 7 ... I seek the fruit that abounds to your account. NKJV









Phil 4:18-19 NLT

■ ¹⁸ At the moment I have all I need—and more! I am generously supplied with the gifts you sent me with Epaphroditus. They are a sweet-smelling sacrifice that is acceptable and pleasing to God. 19 And this same God who takes care of me will supply all your needs from his glorious riches, which have been given to us in Christ Jesus.









Average Giving to Church

- Average giving by adults who attend US protestant churches is \$17 a week.
- 37% of regular church attendees and Evangelicals don't give any money at all.
- 17% of American families have reduced the amount that they give to their local church.
- 7% of church goers have dropped regular giving by 20% or more.









- The first murder in Genesis was committed over an offering.
- Joseph was sold into slavery for 20 pieces of silver
- Jesus was betrayed by Judas for 30 pieces of silver
- Acts 5: Ananias and Sapphira died after lying about how much they had given to the church.







- The church at Philippi was a model church.
- They modelled what is was to really be committed to ministry and to giving sacrificially









Jim Elliott, a missionary who was martyred in Ecuador, whilst sharing the gospel said; "he is no fool who gives away what he cannot keep in order to gain that which he cannot lose".

 Money is a tool only for this life, it has no eternal value in itself.









2 Cor 8: 1-5 - Model Church

- The Philippian Church were a true model of generosity.
- 2 Cor 8: 1-5
- Now I want you to know, dear brothers and sisters, what God in his kindness has done through the churches in Macedonia. ² They are being tested by many troubles, and they are very poor. But they are also filled with abundant joy, which has overflowed in rich generosity.
- ³ For I can testify that they gave not only what they could afford, but far more. And they did it of their own free will. ⁴ They begged us again and again for the privilege of sharing in the gift for the believers in Jerusalem. ⁵ They even did more than we had hoped, for their first action was to give themselves to the Lord and to us, just as God wanted them to do.





2 Cor 8:5

- They first gave themselves to the Lord,
- Then to us,
- Then they were able to give of their finances freely and joyfully.









Martin Luther (the great reformer) said

- There are three conversions that are necessary:
- The conversion of the heart
- The conversion of the mind
- The conversion of the Wallet/Purse
- Of all three, the third one is often the hardest to convert.









Mark 10:17-22

- The Rich Young Ruler
- 17 Now as He was going out on the road, one came running, knelt before Him, and asked Him, "Good Teacher, what shall I do that I may inherit eternal life?"
- 18 So Jesus said to him, "Why do you call Me good? No one is good but One, that is, God. 19 You know the commandments: 'Do not commit adultery,' 'Do not murder,' 'Do not steal,' 'Do not bear false witness,' 'Do not defraud,' 'Honour your father and your mother.' "





- 20 And he answered and said to Him, "Teacher, all these things I have kept from my youth."
- 21 Then Jesus, looking at him, loved him, and said to him, "One thing you lack: Go your way, sell whatever you have and give to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven; and come, take up the cross, and follow Me."
- ²² But he was sad at this word, and went away sorrowful, for he had great possessions.

Principle of Giving

Luke 6:38

• 38 Give, and it will be given to you: good measure, pressed down, shaken together, and running over will be put into your bosom. For with the same measure that you use, it will be measured back to you."

- The generous soul will be made rich,
 And he who waters will also be watered himself.









Principle of Giving

- Prov 3:9
- Honour the LORD with your possessions,
 And with the first fruits of all your increase;
 So your barns will be filled with plenty,
 And your vats will overflow with new wine

 Money leaves your hand but not your life. (sowing)

Conclusion
