

Who, as an eternal spiritual truth exists in the state of being the invisible God's image, existing before all creation





#### Image of God

#### **Colossians 1:15**

Greek word eikon meaning "Image"

Similar to the reflection on a coin.



Jesus said "He who has seen Me has seen the Father" (John 14:9)





#### Firstborn of creation



#### **Colossians 1:15**

Greek word Prototokos meaning "firstborn"

It can mean either priority in time or supremacy in rank.

We know it to mean rank because Paul could have used Protoktistos "first created"







#### Psalms 89:25-27

- <sup>25</sup> I will set his hand over the sea, his right hand over the rivers.
- <sup>26</sup> He will call out to me, 'You are my Father, my God, the Rock my Savior.'
- <sup>27</sup> And I will appoint him to be my firstborn, the most exalted of the kings of the earth









#### John 1:1-3 & 14

1 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. <sup>2</sup> He was in the beginning with God. <sup>3</sup> All things were made through Him, and without Him nothing was made that was made.

14 And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth









#### Philippians 2:9-11

<sup>9</sup> Therefore God also has highly exalted Him and given Him the name which is above every name, <sup>10</sup> that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of those in heaven, and of those on earth, and of those under the earth, <sup>11</sup> and *that* every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ *is* Lord, to the glory of God the Father.









#### **NKJV**

#### New World Translation

15 He is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn of all creation 16 because by means of him all other things were created in the heavens and on the earth, the things visible and the things invisible, whether they are thrones or lordships or governments or authorities. All other things have been created through him and for him. 17 Also, he is before all other things, and by means of him all other things were made to exist, 18 and he is the head of the body, the congregation. He is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead, so that he might become the one who is first in all things;
