### RECONCILITION

- The bond was broken in the garden
- God wants us back
- Reconciliation: from the Latin root words re, meaning "again," and concilare, meaning "to make friendly."
- bring back to a former state of harmony
- Katallagé: exchange





#### GET TO A PLACE OF RECONCILITION

- Establish peace. Romans 5:1 <sup>5</sup> Therefore, since we have been made right in God's sight by faith, we have peace<sup>[a]</sup> with God because of what Jesus Christ our Lord has done for us
- Break the cycle of strife. Ephesians 2:16
   <sup>16</sup> Together as one body, Christ reconciled both groups to God by means of his death on the cross, and our hostility toward each other was put to death
- Build a new relationship. 2 Corinthians
   5:17 <sup>17</sup> This means that anyone who belongs to Christ has become a new person. The old life is gone; a new life has begun!





#### GET TO A PLACE OF RECONCILITION:

- Forgive Ideally reconciliation prevents, once and for all, the use of the past as the seed of renewed conflict Micah 7:18 NLT Where is another God like you, who pardons the guilt of the remnant, overlooking the sins of his special people? You will not stay angry with your people forever, because you delight in showing unfailing love.
  - Forgiveness isn't the goal, relationship and intimacy with God is
  - Forgiveness doesn't require the offender to be present.





#### GET TO A PLACE OF RECONCILITION:

- In some cases healing must take place for there to be complete reconciliation. Psalm 147:3 He heals the broken-hearted and bandages their wounds.
- Healing may take time
- Ask Christ to heal you

• We are to guard our hearts and minds :

- same way that God did the garden
- The same way Jesus protected his mind from peters response

And he has committed to us the message of reconciliation. <sup>20</sup> We are therefore Christ's ambassadors, as though God were making his appeal through us. We implore you on Christ's behalf: Be reconciled to God. <sup>21</sup>God made him who had no sin to be sin<sup>[a]</sup> for us, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God.
