### Paul speaks directly to three groups:

- 1. Wives and Husbands
- 2. Children and Parents
- 3. Servants and Masters
- Notice the priority of order First what we might see as the weaker, then what we might see as the stronger.









## Why this important admonition?

- 1. Families make up society
- 2. The health of the family is the health of society
- 3. Our working lives consume a large portion of our lives









#### Instructions To Wives - Colossians 3:18 - 25 & 4: 1

<sup>18</sup> Wives, understand and support your husbands by submitting to them in ways that honour the Master. NLT

<sup>18</sup> Wives, understand and support your husbands by submitting to them in ways that honour the Master. MSG

<sup>18</sup> Wives, be <sup>[e]</sup> subject to your husbands [out of respect for their position as protector, and their accountability to God], as is proper *and* <sup>[f]</sup> fitting in the Lord. AMP









# Wives:

<u>Understand</u> and <u>supporting</u> your husband by submitting to them <u>in ways that honour the Lord.</u> (MSG) equality,

Submission doesn't diminish nor does it mar the dignity of what it is to be a woman. **Submission must be voluntary, off ones own free well!** 

Jesus came into this world to submit to the will of God and in doing that, did not surrender or lose his equality with God, micah.org.uk









#### Instructions To Husbands - Colossians 3:18 - 25 & 4: 1

<sup>19</sup> Husbands, love your wives and never treat them harshly. NLT

<sup>19</sup> Husbands, go all out in love for your wives. Don't take advantage of them. MSG

<sup>19</sup> Husbands, love your wives [with an affectionate, sympathetic, selfless love that always seeks the best for them] and do not be embittered or resentful toward them [because of the responsibilities of marriage]. AMP









# **Husbands:**

<sup>19</sup> Husbands, go all out in love for your wives. Don't take advantage of them. (MSG)

Let love be the driving factor and motivator in your relationship. Not Power, or ego.

Jesus humbled and emptied himself and husbands must be willing to humble and empty themselves for the sake of their wives.

#### ITS AMAZING THAT JESUS IS AN EXAMPLE TO BOTH WIVES AND HUSBANDS.

**Example to wives:** Jesus <u>willingly</u> submitted himself to the father's will.

2. Examples to husbands: Jesus loved the church and laid down his life for her.

3. God is perfect but we are flawed – Both Wives and Husbands have their shortcomings







#### Instructions To Children - Colossians 3:18 - 25 & 4: 1

<sup>20</sup> Children, always obey your parents, for this pleases the Lord. NLT

<sup>20</sup> Children, do what your parents tell you. This delights the Master no end. MSG

<sup>20</sup> Children, obey your parents [as God's representatives] in all things, for this [attitude of respect and obedience] is well-pleasing <sup>[g]</sup>to the Lord [and will bring you God's promised blessings]. AMP







# **Children:**

- <sup>20</sup> Children, always obey your parents, for this pleases the Lord.
- Living obediently prepares children for everyday life in the future.
- Paul is referring to minors.

#### Eph 6:1-3

<sup>3</sup> If you honour your father and mother, "things will go well for you, and you will have a long life on the earth.









#### Instructions To Parents - Colossians 3:18 - 25 & 4: 1

<sup>21</sup> Fathers, do not aggravate your children, or they will become discouraged. NLT

<sup>21</sup> Parents, don't come down too hard on your children or you'll crush their spirits. MSG

<sup>21</sup> Fathers, do not <u>provoke or irritate or exasperate</u> your children [with demands that are trivial or unreasonable or humiliating or abusive; nor by favouritism or indifference; treat them tenderly with lovingkindness], so they will not lose heart and become discouraged or unmotivated [with their spirits broken]. AMP









#### Instructions To Workers - Colossians 3:18 – 25 & 4: 1

<sup>22 - 25</sup> Servants, do what you're told by your earthly masters. And don't just do the minimum that will get you by. Do your best. Work from the heart for your real Master, for God, confident that you'll get paid in full when you come into your inheritance. Keep in mind always that the ultimate Master you're serving is Christ. The sullen servant who does shoddy work will be held responsible. Being a follower of Jesus doesn't cover up bad work. MSG









#### Instructions To Workers - Colossians 3:18 - 25 & 4: 1

- 1. Do your best at work
- 2. Work from the heart as thought working to glorify God
- 3. Remember that God is watching you
- 4. Remember that God will reward you

# Workers:

- 1. Serve as though you're serving the Lord and not man.
- 2. Your attitude towards your work and service is key
