Mark 10:45 - 'For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve...'

SACRIFICE (S.E.R.V.E)

Romans 12:1 – Present your bodies a living sacrifice.

- Service is not always convenient; it requires sacrifice.
- It may mean giving up comfort, time, or resources.
- Jesus made the ultimate sacrifice on the cross.

Application: It takes more dying to <u>self</u> to be a living sacrifice than a dead one!



EMPOWER (S.E.R.V.E)

Hebrews 10:24 – Stir up love and good works.

- Service empowers and uplifts others.
- Acts of service should strengthen others.
- Ask: Does my service make others stronger?

Application: Your service should positively impact others.



REFLECT CHRIST (S.E.R.V.E) pt1.

John 13:14–15 – Wash one another's feet.

- Serving others is imitating Jesus.
- To serve like Jesus, we must become like Jesus did.
- When we serve, people see Christ in us.



REFLECT CHRIST (S.E.R.V.E) pt2.

Philippians 2:8 – He humbled Himself and became obedient to death.

- Jesus humbled Himself and became a servant.
- Service reflects humility and love.

Application: Let Christ live in you and through you!



VALUE OTHERS (S.E.R.V.E)

Philippians 2:3-4 - Esteem others better than yourself.

- Serving means putting others first.
- We value others with time, attention, and care.
- Humility is the posture of service.

Application: Christian service will cost you something – even your old life!



ETERNAL IMPACT (S.E.R.V.E)

Matthew 25:21 - Well done, good and faithful servant.

- Service has eternal rewards.
- God measures greatness by faithfulness, not status.
- Every act of service counts in eternity.

Application: Eternal life with Jesus is the reward for service – so serve well.



CONCLUSION & APPLICATION

To S.E.R.V.E is to Sacrifice, Empower, Reflect Christ, Value Others, and live for Eternal Impact.

- Service is about posture, not position; testimony, not titles.
- Every act of service declares: Jesus is Lord of my life.
