The Heart of Service

"Having loved His own who were in the world, He loved them to the end."

JOHN 13:1 NKJV

The Heart of Service (v.1)

- Service is motivated by love, not obligation.
- Love makes service meaningful and lasting.

Application: Am I serving out of duty, recognition, or love?

The Posture of Service

"Jesus... rose from supper and laid aside His garments, took a towel and girded Himself... and began to wash the disciples' feet."

JOHN 13:3-5 NKJV

The Posture of Service (v.3-5)

- His Identity fuelled His humility Jesus knew who He was.
- With all authority, He picked up a towel and served.

Application: Humility is thinking of others more

The **Challenge** of Service

"Peter said... 'You shall never wash my feet!' Jesus answered... 'If I do not wash you, you have no part with Me.'"

JOHN 13:8 NKJV

The Challenge of Service (v.6-8)

- Jesus instituted Kingdom leadership, by a simple act of service – washing His disciple's feet.
- Jesus came to wash away our <u>sins</u>, our <u>pride</u>, our <u>fears</u>, our <u>doubts</u> – We all need to be washed by Jesus!

Application: Service can stretch us beyond comfort.

The **Example** of Service

"If I then, your Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, you also ought to wash one another's feet."

JOHN 13:14 NKJV

The Example of Service (v.12-15)

- Jesus' act was an example, not just a moment.
- Service = discipleship in action.

Application: Look for "feet to wash" — at home, in church, in community.

The **Blessing** of Service

"If you know these things, blessed are you if you do them."

JOHN 13:17 NKJV

The Blessing of Service (v.17)

- The blessings come from doing, not just knowing.
- Serving brings true joy and fulfilment.

Application: Serving may feel costly but leads to greater blessing.

Conclusion

Service is not weakness — it is greatness in God's Kingdom!

• The world measures greatness by how many people serve you!

• God measures greatness by how many people you serve.
