Key Thought

Prayer is powerful not because we are eloquent, but because <u>God</u> is <u>faithful!</u>



1. God Hears The Imperfect Prayer

ROMANS 8:26 (NKJV)

Like wise the Spirit also helps in our weaknesses. For we do not know what we should pray for as we ought, but the Spirit Himself makes intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered.



1. God Hears The Imperfect Prayer

1 SAMUEL 1:10-13 (NKJV)

- Hannah prayed silently in anguish.
- God heard her heart.
- God gave her a Son The Prophet Samuel

Key Thought

2. God Responds To Persistent Faith

LUKE 18:1 (NKJV)

"Men ought always to pray and not lose heart."



2. God Responds To Persistent Faith

1 KINGS 18:41-46 (NKJV)

- Elijah prayed repeatedly for rain.
- The Rain didn't come at first.
- Sometime later a small cloud appeared.
- The drought ended and the rain poured.

ACTS 12:1–17
